Building trust in public financial management by creating and strengthening continental synergies for the integrated and sustainable development of Africa.



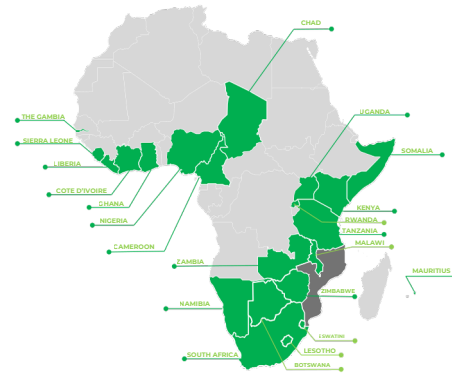
