QnA - Broadening Reporting Role of Accountants-General Department to Embrace Sustainability Reporting

1. How important is the issue of developing skills capacity for AGs across Africa to ensure they can manage the transition to sustainability reporting?

Current Accounting Landscape:

Traditional financial reporting, while important, now needs to incorporate Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) factors to assess an organization's long-term viability and impact. This shift requires AGs to expand their expertise beyond historical financial performance.

Challenges to be faced by Accountants-General in Onboarding Sustainability Reporting:

- **New Frameworks and Standards:** Existing accounting frameworks often lack provisions for capturing ESG data. AGs must familiarize themselves with new standards like the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) Standards, IFRS-SS...which define the content and format of sustainability reports. It is important to note the Association will position itself in anticipation of the processes by International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board to develop the equivalent of IFRS S 2 in the second half on 2025.
- **Data Collection and Measurement:** Sustainability reporting involves non-financial data such as greenhouse gas emissions and

community engagement metrics. AGs need skills to collect, analyze, and ensure the reliability of this data alongside financial information.

- **Internal Control and Assurance:** Accountants-General must adapt the existing internal control frameworks to cover ESG data effectively. They need expertise in assessing control effectiveness and providing assurance on the accuracy and completeness of sustainability reports.
- **Integration and Consolidation:** Sustainability information must be integrated with financial reports for a holistic view. Accountants-General should understand how to consolidate and present this information consistently and transparently.

Benefits of Skilled AGs in Sustainability Reporting:

- **Enhanced Credibility and Reliability:** Skilled AGs can provide assurance on the quality of sustainability information, boosting investor confidence and stakeholder trust.
- **Improved Risk Management:** Understanding ESG factors allows for a comprehensive risk assessment, leading to better decision-making and risk mitigation.
